



## Sixth Form Dress Code

### *Gentlemen*

- A pair of trousers suitable for a work or school environment
- A smart shirt with a tie
- A smart polo shirt (**only once permission has been given by your Head of Sixth in the hotter weather**)
- A jumpers or a cardigan
- A suit
- A blazer
- Appropriate smart footwear for a work or school environment

Denim / Leather Jackets

Sweatshirts / Hoodies / Casual t-shirts / Branded logo clothing

Shorts / Jeans / Leggings / Jogging bottoms / Jeggings / Combat trousers

Trainers / Plimsoles / Flip Flops / Ugg (or similar) boots / DM (or similar) Boots
